

VLN – Enterprise Terms of Service & White-Label Agreement

This document defines the Terms of Service, advanced limitation of liability clauses, and White-Label enterprise provisions for VLN (Virtual Licensing Network).

TERMS OF SERVICE

- 1. Service Description: VLN provides a licensing, forensic verification, and digital provenance infrastructure for AI-generated content.
- 2. User Responsibilities: Users must ensure they hold necessary rights for uploaded content and comply with applicable laws.
- 3. Intellectual Property: VLN retains ownership of its software, architecture, and proprietary systems. Users retain ownership of uploaded content unless contractually transferred.
- 4. License Grant: VLN grants users a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable right to access and use the platform.
- 5. Prohibited Use: Unauthorized reverse engineering, abuse of licensing system, fraudulent activity, or unlawful content is strictly prohibited.
- 6. Service Availability: VLN aims to maintain service continuity but does not guarantee uninterrupted availability.
- 7. Termination: VLN may suspend or terminate accounts for breach of terms or security risks.

LIMITATION OF LIABILITY (ENTERPRISE LEVEL)

- 1. VLN provides technical traceability and verification tools and does not guarantee prevention of third-party misuse outside its infrastructure.
- 2. VLN shall not be liable for indirect, incidental, or consequential damages including lost profits or business interruption.
- 3. Total aggregate liability shall not exceed the total fees paid by the client in the preceding 12 months.
- 4. No liability shall arise from events beyond reasonable control (force majeure).
- 5. Clients are responsible for lawful distribution and compliance with third-party platform policies.

WHITE-LABEL ENTERPRISE CLAUSES

- 1. White-Label Provision: VLN may provide its infrastructure under client branding without public reference to VLN.
- 2. Branding Rights: Client may present the system as its own integrated solution subject to contractual agreement.
- 3. Confidentiality: All technical documentation, APIs, and system architecture remain confidential.
- 4. Audit Rights: VLN reserves the right to audit system use to prevent abuse.
- 5. Data Role Definition: In white-label integrations, VLN acts as Data Processor; client acts as Data Controller unless otherwise specified.
- 6. Security Commitment: VLN maintains cryptographic integrity mechanisms, signed audit packs, and append-only ledger infrastructure.

ENTERPRISE SECURITY & TRUST ADDENDUM

- 1. Cryptographic Hashing (SHA-256) applied to digital assets and audit documentation.
- 2. Digital Signature of forensic audit packs using secure server-side key management.
- 3. Append-only event ledger ensuring immutable traceability records.
- 4. Role-based access control and encrypted transmission (HTTPS/TLS).
- 5. Breach Notification: Clients will be notified within 72 hours of confirmed security incidents.
